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Amy English is the Deputy Staff Director of the U.S. Senate Foreign Relations Committee, bringing over a decade of experience in diplomacy, foreign policy, and strategic leadership across government, nonprofit, and international sectors. Previously, she served as Foreign Policy Advisor to Senator Jeanne Shaheen, advancing U.S. priorities on global security, international development, and democratic governance. Before joining the Senate, Amy was Director of Advancement and External Affairs at Pathfinder International. She also co-founded the NextGen Chamber of Commerce Foundation, the first U.S. business organization dedicated to empowering entrepreneurs under forty. Earlier in her career, Amy spent nearly four years at the British Embassy in Washington, DC. She was awarded the British Empire Medal for her contributions to U.K.–U.S. relations. A Fellow and Executive Committee member of the British-American Project, Amy continues to strengthen transatlantic cooperation through leadership and policy engagement. She holds a Master's degree in International Relations from the University of Warwick, and a Bachelor's degree in Political Science with concentrations in Asian Studies and French from the University of San Diego.
